DAY 1
ARRIVAL VANCOUVER**A 25 KM**

After arrival, transfer (not included) from the airport to the hotel. Check in and free time.

**DAY 2**

VANCOUVER - VICTORIA - VANCOUVER

A 230 KM

This full-day trip to Victoria begins with a cruise through the scenic Gulf Islands and includes a visit to the acclaimed Butchart Gardens. Afterwards continue to Victoria for a city sightseeing tour that encompasses Victoria's stately homes and gardens as well as historic landmarks. You will see the University of Victoria and Beacon Hill Park and pass the Royal British Columbia Museum, Thunderbird Park, the Parliament Buildings and the exclusive homes of the Uplands and Oak Bay. You will return to Vancouver in the early evening. Overnight in Vancouver.

**DAY 3**

VANCOUVER - KAMLOOPS (TRAIN)

A 430 KM

Transfer (not included) from the hotel to the Vancouver Railway Station to embark the Rocky Mountaineer train. The first stretch takes you through lush farmlands, past historic towns and follows the spectacular Thompson River, known for its outdoor activities, specially rafting. In the afternoon you will travel through the 'cowboy country' ranchlands and along the rushing torrents of the Fraser and Thompson Rivers. Lodging in Kamloops taken care off by the Rocky Mountaineer company.

**DAY 4**

KAMLOOPS - JASPER (TRAIN)

A 450 KM

Breakfast in the train. The second part of this wonderful train trip brings you to Jasper. Leaving Kamloops, you travel through the spacious region of ranches and forests to reach the Alberta border. Passing through some tunnels and over the Kicking Horse Pass, the train brings you through the majestic Rockies with some of the most spectacular sights in Western Canada. Late afternoon, arrival in Jasper and check-in for 2 nights at your hotel.

**DAY 5**

JASPER - VISIT

A 10 KM

Take the day to create your own adventure in Jasper. Perhaps you may wish to arrange a thrilling rafting trip down the Athabasca River or climb aboard a motorcycle sidecar for a different touring experience along the park's scenic roads. Optional excursions to beautiful Maligne Lake and Maligne Canyon will be offered too.

**DAY 6**

JASPER - BANFF (AUTOCAR)

A 290 KM

Day trip by coach from Jasper to Banff - Via the Icefield Parkway with impressive panoramas of shining lakes, enormous glaciers, water falls, ... You can enjoy an unforgettable trip with the 'Ice Explorer' on the Athabasca Glacier and walk over the Glacier Skywalk, a glass plateau 30 meters above the Sunwapta Canyon. Travel to Banff and arrival late afternoon for lodging.

**DAY 7**

BANFF NATIONAL PARK

A 20 KM

Banff is yours to discover today. You can visit the Cave and Basin and Bow Falls, and take a thrilling gondola ride to the summit of Sulphur Mountain. Other activities offered in the park for your pleasure include river rafting, biking, horseback riding and guided hiking. Overnight in Banff.

**DAY 8**

BANFF - DEPARTURE CALGARY

A 140 KM

At morning, transfer per coach through the rich and spacious ranch area of Kananaskis to Calgary Airport. Return flight or extension possible with supplement.
