Great Lakes Treasures - ex Ontario Nature adventure. 16 days/15 nights. Start: Toronto - End: Toronto.

## DAY 1

### ARRIVAL TORONTO

**A** 15 KM

Arrival at the airport of Toronto and pick up the rental car. Drive to the hotel and you will receive your roadbook at the hotel reception desk. The rest of the day is free to discover this multicultural city. Toronto offers lots of restaurants, an exuberant and diverse nightlife and many shopping possibilities.



## DAY 2

### TORONTO

**A** 20 KM

Time to discover the city: C.N. Tower (Canadian National) for a fantastic view over the city and the direct surrounding. Discover the architectural secrets of this unique construction, make a walk on the glass observation plateau or taste the refined cuisine in the turning restaurant. Entrance ticket to the Ripley's Aquarium included. Once back on solid ground, you can stroll through the shopping streets, the shopping center EATON, the beautiful old and new City Hall, the wonderful Ontario Museum and much more. Also the theater and the vibrant nightlife has much to offer. Accommodation in Toronto.



## DAY 3

### TORONTO - HUNTSVILLE

**A** 220 KM

Travel north passing charming villages, through the wonderful natural region of Muskoka, where you can visit the Muskoka Pioneer Village. The end destination for today is Huntsville, located just out of the Algonquin Provincial Park. This beautiful park is specially known for its vacation setting, lake and river activities and countless walking trails with stunning fauna and flora to discover. Accommodation in Huntsville.



## DAY 4

### HUNTSVILLE

**A** 25 KM

The parks that surround the area all offer exciting day trails to explore ancient forests and lakes. Arrowhead Provincial Park is a smaller park with trails and a swimming beach, perfect for a day excursion. You can also enjoy a visit to the outdoor Group of 7 natural art gallery, celebrating the works of early 20th century artists that created a world-famous Canadian Impressionism style. Overnight in Huntsville.



## DAY 5

### HUNTSVILLE - KILLARNEY PROVINCIAL PARK

**A** 300 KM

The less known, but yet so beautiful hinterland of Ontario with little villages blooming through wood industry and mining, will be discovered. Lodgings for the two following days at the Sportsman's Inn resort & Marina.



## DAY 6

### KILLARNEY PROVINCIAL PARK

**A** 10 KM

This area is known as one of the best hiking and camping areas in the province, and you'll discover why as you further explore this striking landscape of pre-Cambrian granite and sparkling lakes. Known for its superb camping, Killarney Provincial Park also offers excellent canoeing and hiking trails.



**DAY 7**

KILLARNEY PROVINCIAL PARK - TIMMINS

**A** 415 KM

Travel further north to Timmins, rich of natural minerals, especially gold and has more than 500 lakes and rivers. Enjoy the wonderful wooded and rocky landscapes. Accommodation in Timmins.

**DAY 8**

TIMMINS

**A** 10 KM

Discover the city with the Golden Heart. Visit the local art galleries, play some golf and follow one of the hikes through the Boreal Woods. Optional activity: Discover the lakes and rivers by kayak or canoe and watch closely: Otters and beavers can be spotted.

**DAY 9**

TIMMINS - WAWA

**A** 330 KM

Leave Timmins behind and drive to the west, to Wawa. The scenery in this region is Boreal Woods, dramatic cliffs and lakes. Once arrived in Wawa, you can relax in the park along the water or discover the local history in the Sandy Beach Eco - Interpretive Park.

**DAY 10**

WAWA - SAULT STE. MARIE

**A** 230 KM

Travel to the south via the Trans Canada Highway, along the ridged and rocky coast of Lake Superior. Sault Ste. Marie, one of the biggest cities in the northwest of Ontario and offer all facilities of a big city. The city is only a couple of minutes away from the big forests and valleys, which attracts visitors all over the province. Lodgings.

**DAY 11**

SAULT STE. MARIE

**A** 20 KM

This city and its surroundings are specially known for its eco tourism, with a lot of parks, such as Pancake Bay, Batchawana Bay and Lake Superior Provincial Park. Optional activity: Embark on to the Agawa Canyon Train for a one day excursion, 183 km north of the city. When the track comes to the farthest and highest point of Agawa Canyon, it descends 150 meters over 16 km. to the valley of the canyon. There might still be time for a short walk and back to Sault Ste. Marie.

**DAY 12**

SAULT STE. MARIE - MANITOULIN ISLAND

**A** 350 KM

The day starts with a relaxing drive through the impressive decor of forests and lakes. The Manitoulin Island is one of the biggest islands in the world in a freshwater lake. There are five reservations from the former 'Ojibwa' tribe on this island, just as the oldest town with long, high and tall houses, which are about 500 years old. Learn and discover everything about this little unique piece of Canada and enjoy the variety in and around your hotel. Lodgings at the Manitoulin Island.

**DAY 13**

MANITOULIN ISLAND

**A** 10 KM

A nature's masterpiece with more than 100 lakes, such as the Manitou Lake. The island is perfect to float around, to fish or to dive to the spectacular underwater world. If you prefer solid ground, the Assinick museum, the Current-Howland museum and the Mississagi Lighthouse Museum in the lighthouse are splendid alternatives.

**DAY 14**

MANITOULIN ISLAND - TOBERMORY

**A** 75 KM

At the south coast of the island, you embark the ferry that brings you from South Baymouth to Tobermory, during a 2 hours relaxing cruise. You drive to Bruce Peninsula Park, with lots of walking trails, sport activities and unique places, such as Fathom Five Marine Park, an underwaterworld park, where divers look for shipwrecks. Lodgings.

**DAY 15**

TOBERMORY - NIAGARA FALLS

**A** 380 KM


You drive along the Bruce Peninsula en route to Niagara Falls, the 'honey moon capital of the world'. Approaching the southern reaches of Ontario, you pass through hills featuring a variety of walking and cycling trails. The road continues through the lush orchards and vineyards of the Niagara growing region, boasting many world class winery chateaus that offer tasting and touring. **DAY 16**
